

CanDo! Days is a hands-on arts experience that sparks imagination through exploration of various art forms, discovery, and learning from professional artists. Students rotate through up to four sessions in theater, movement, music, and visual art. This is also a wonderful opportunity for teachers to see their students in a different light. We highly encourage you to participate alongside your students - and have fun!

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Plan to arrive at the Education Complex no later than 8:50 a.m., as the program will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and conclude at 12:35 p.m., unless alternative arrangements have been made in advance.

Please note: if your group arrives before 8:40 a.m., you are welcome to offload your students from their buses; however, you may need to wait with them in the grassy area of the MACC's McCoy Courtyard until our staff has completed setup.

GROUPS

The program requires **four groups**- one for each class rotation. Please divide and identify your groups as A, B, C, and D prior to arrival. Each group must have at least one chaperone present. Teachers and chaperones are encouraged to actively participate with their students. Please note that the MACC's Teaching Artists are not responsible for behavioral management.

NAME TAGS

Please ensure each student wears a name tag with their first name printed large enough for instructors to read from a distance.

ATTIRE

Students should wear slippers or sandals and comfortable clothing that allows for easy movement. Girls may find wearing shorts most comfortable. All students will be participating in I Ola Kākou Āpau (IOKA Movement), which involves sitting on floors and grassy areas.

LUNCH

Please have each student bring a lunch in an enclosed lunch bag or box, along with a beverage. Students will have a lunch break in the courtyard.
